Knowing how to visualize the space for how it will be experienced by the people who will inhabit it, arousing emotions and a sense of well-being.


An architectural project cannot disregard its geographical location and it is now necessary to ensure that the project blends in with its surroundings by entering into a deep connection of respect and harmony.

This spark is what makes our hearts beat faster, what makes a project fit for human beings, thought out with care and creativity.




CONCEPT BEDROOM







B E D R O O M

Per la camera da letto di questo progetto si è scelto di creare una cornice in bianco e nero a parete e pavimento con alcuni tocchi di colore dati dalla carta da parati vinilica con decoro geometrico, il tappeto INK.RUGS® e la boiserie in legno di betulla Lineadeko. 




CONCEPT WELLNESS


In the torrid heat of the desert rises a wellness oasis, a hotel with a relaxation area and spa. In the fluidity of the sandy, desert environment, a building with sharp, angular geometric shapes stands out, creating a contrast that attracts the observer's curiosity. The spaces are characterised by large windows that open the view to the surrounding environment to ideally connect the indoor space with the outdoor space.



WELLNESS

La carta da parati in fibra di vetro EQ·Dekor crea un ulteriore sfondo scenografico nella parte esterna della zona wellness con piscina, in cui viene ricreato uno sfondo di vegetazione dai toni verdi come se fosse un'oasi. All'interno invece i pannelli in legno Lineadeko ricordano motivi fluidi di ispirazione naturale sulle pareti combinandosi con la moquette a pavimento.

The EQ·Dekor fiber glass wallpaper creates an additional scenic backdrop in the outdoor part of the wellness area with swimming pool, in which a backdrop of vegetation in green tones is recreated as if it were an oasis. 




CONCEPT BATHROOM






B A T H R O O M

The Lineadeko panels add a further level of softness and warmth with digitally printed birchwood.






CONCEPT RESTAURANT


RESTAURANT






CONCEPT C O W O R K I N G





COWORKING






CONCEPT HALL AREA





HALL AREA
